Changes Implemented as Units Expire April 18, 2022

Unit One voting has ended. The Election Committee has verified that Unit one did not pass. Unit Two is still short for returned votes and it does not look like it will pass either.

Per legal guidance, Unit One will no longer a be member of the POA as of May 18th, since the CLRs governed the POA and were not voted to be extended. However Unit One property owners are still members of the Council of Co-owners, which is governed by the Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws. The Non-Profit Corporation is perpetual. I know this is confusing as the Non-Profit has the same name as the POA. They are two separate organizations with two different governing documents.

Certain privileges were granted by the CLRs, paid for with the assessments collected, and which will no longer be in effect in Unit One after May 18th. Things such as access to the pool and reduced rates for the golf course and mailboxes. Since Unit One will no longer governed by the CLRs, things such as compliance and assessments can no longer be enforced. All issues with compliance must go to the county or the sheriff.

As members of the Non-Profit Corporation / Council of Co-Owners, Unit One property owners are still eligible to vote for board members, serve on the board and committees, unless their voting privileges have been suspended. There will, however, be a fee schedule implemented for the members of the Non-Profit / Council of Co-Owners to maintain records, office staffing, assignment and maintaining of mailboxes. The POA, for the last 50+ years, has undertaken the responsibility of the purchase of the cluster boxes and their assignment, placement and maintenance and will continue to do so. Legally we must maintain their ownership records and this does costs money.

We are still looking into alternatives to maintain the community and its amenities. As we come up with new questions or concerns, we are seeking guidance and answers from our attorneys. When we learn more, we will keep you updated.

PLEASE NOTE

There have been posts on Facebook stating that the CLRs should have been rewritten and voted on a couple of years ago, when the board first began the effort to extend the CLRs. This subject has been discussed during a number of previous monthly board meetings.

According to the Articles of Incorporation and the CLR's, changes to either of these documents requires a 75% approval vote of all property owners in Valle Vista. The board felt that goal was unreachable, considering only approximately 50% of property owners have voted to approve the extension, sadly quite short of the 66.67% approval required to extend the CLR's.


