A Message From Chief Hoak

The rains came and yes, the burn ban is off. Burn permits are available by calling our office at 928-757-3151. Please remember the keep burn piles small, have a hose and hand tools ready. Open burning is for yard debris, do not burn trash, plastic or other non-organic materials.

There has been a lot of mis-information about fire hydrants in Valle Vista. I have received numerous calls from residents in the community about fire hydrants. Here are the facts. There are hydrants connected to the golf course irrigations system. These are fed from a water tank about Valle Vista. The POA owns this system and is responsible for maintaining the system. They purchase water from Cerbat Water Company. The 5 hydrants are located near the club house and around the golf course.

These are the hydrants the POA is talking about no longer maintaining. Beside this being a violation of the fire code, this will have a detrimental effect on you homeowners' insurance. The Insurance Services Organization (ISO) provides a rating of fire departments and available water supply. Valle Vista is currently an ISO 3. We are scheduled to be rated again in 2023. ISO rates the entire community, not just the area around the golf course.

Essentially, turning off the 5 hydrants impacts every homeowner in Valle Vista.

There are other hydrants in Valle Vista that are on the Cerbat Water system. They are not affected by the proposed irrigation system shut down. I met with Mike Neal, owner of Cerbat Water Company. He is not interested in taking possession of the irrigation system due to the cost of maintain the system and the lack of maintenance has caused water leaks. Northern Arizona Fire District has no input over the POA's financial issues. All we can do is cite the POA for not complying with the fire code. As stated earlier, the lack of hydrants will have an impact on how much your property insurance will increase. I have already changed our response plan to send additional water tenders to Valle Vista if we have a structure fire in the area.

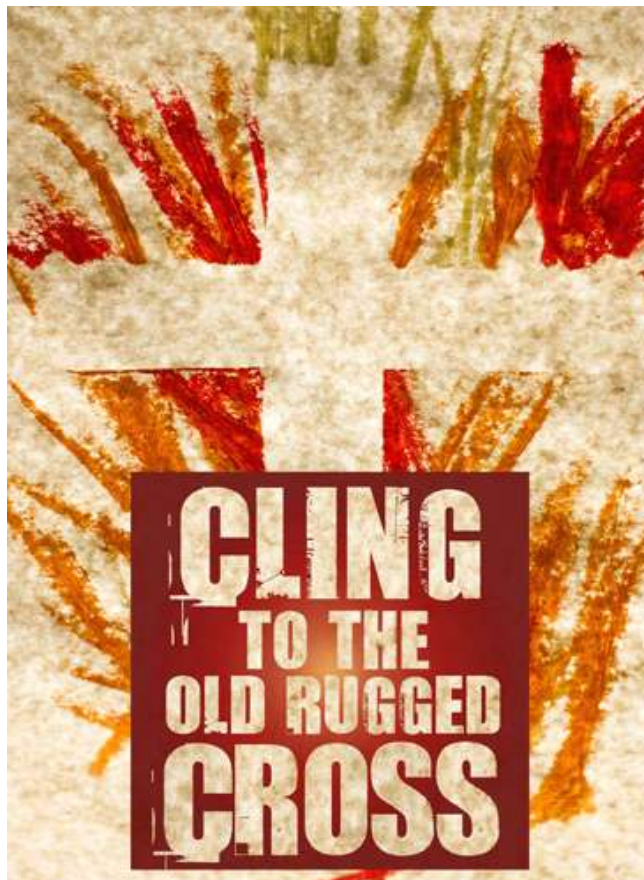

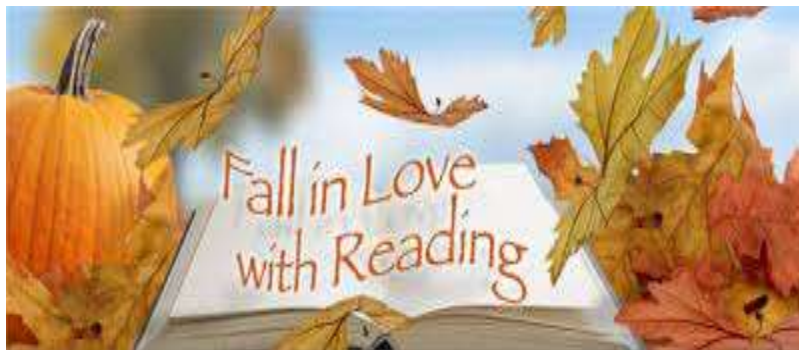

One of the most exciting sections in the library is our biography shelves. No, biography is *not* dull. Ask Lin-Manuel Miranda who took Ron

Chernow's biography of Alexander Hamilton as the inspiration for a Broadway musical. According to the Show-Bz Cheat Sheet website:

Lin-Manuel Miranda was browsing for a beach-read while on celebratory vacation for the success of his musical *In The Heights*. Luckily, he just so happened to pick up Ron Chernow's biography *Alexander Hamilton*. In an interview for CBS's *60 Minutes*, Lin-Manuel stated that prior to starting the book, he had very little knowledge of the founding father's history,

"I knew Hamilton died in a duel with the vice president. I knew he was on the \$10 bill. But really, I was just browsing the biography section. It could have been Truman."

On reading the book he was caught by the idea that Hamilton was an immigrant who rose to be George Washington's aide-de-camp in the Continental Army, co-authored the Federalist Papers, founded the Bank of New York, led the Federalist Party and became the Treasurer of the United States. He translated that idea into an award-winning hip-hop musical.

Not all biographies will be found in the Biography shelving section, although it is convenient to browse those shelves. If you use the library catalog to look up by Keyword or Title the book that inspired the musical *Hamilton*, you'll find two of the library district's copies are shelved in Biography and two are shelved in adult non-fiction under 973.4902. Even when you try to sort your home collection of books, you will usually find there is more than one place a book will fit so don't be surprised when that happens at the library.
